
Year 6 Autumn 1 Newsletter

Tempestuous Tudors






history

The children will develop their understanding British history, with particular attention to life the in Tudor times. They will learn about the chronology of the Kings and Queens and examine the religious and political issues of their reign.

- Looking at the structure of sonnets and creating their own
- Writing their own tragedy
- Enriching vocabulary and developing sentence structures using Elizabethan grammatical structures

Art

In art, the children will develop their sketching techniques, including the use of different grades of pencil; they will develop their understanding of the purpose of portraits in Tudor times and examine the works of key artists of the era such as Holbein.
